BOOKS AND BOOKSELLERS.

We are asked to state that though Mr. Aleister Crowley's "Orpheus, a Lyrical Legend," uses a title also given to Mr. Arthur Dillon's narrative poem of "Orpheus," recently re-issued, the difference in the literary form of these is probably sufficient to prevent confusion between them.
